- Next week we will try a new midweek option designed to be a time of prayer, announcements and fellowship. This will take place on Zoom. A code will be sent each week. See info below:



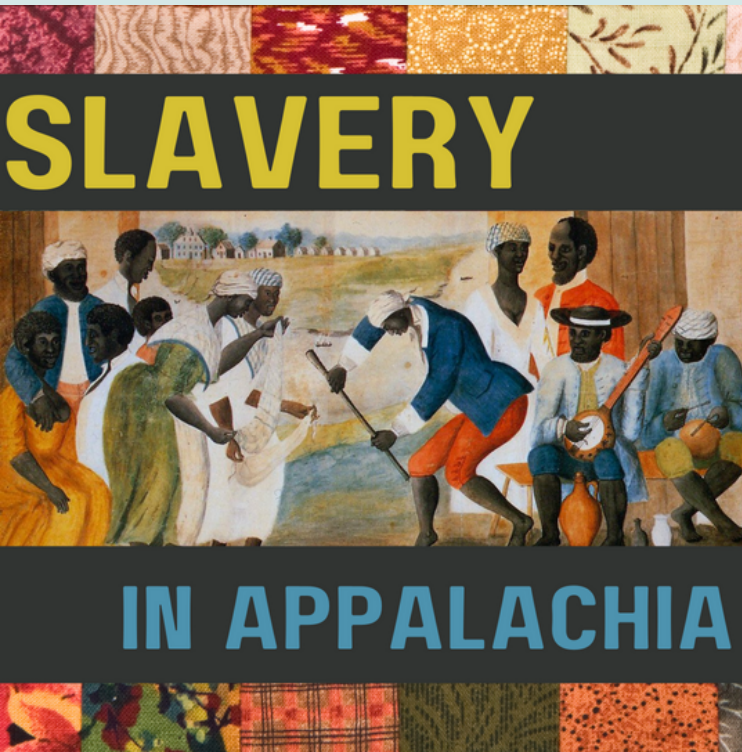

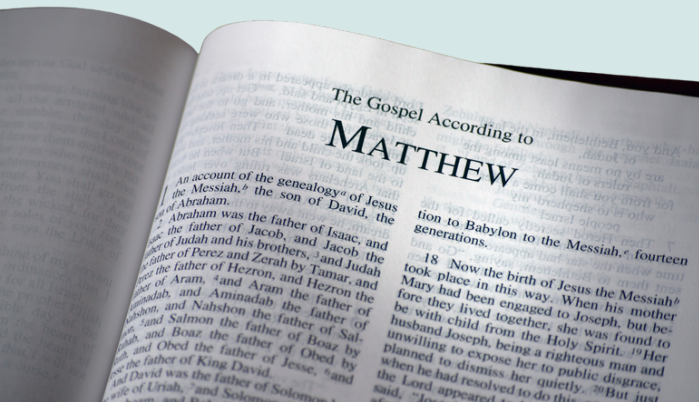
